Decoupage Valentine Tray Mon, February 1 @ 1:30pm

Supply List

- Any type of plastic tray - a lid from a take-out food container will work!
- Assortment of seasonal tissue paper; 1-2 sheets
- Artificial (silk) flowers, craft glue, scissors, paint brush
- Mod Podge (or Elmer's glue thinned with water)
- "Bling" – any decorative items you'd like to use as accents

Instructions:

1. Cut tissue paper into small shapes
2. Paint entire tray with mod podge
3. Arrange tissue paper pieces on tray – paint entire tray surface
4. Allow to dry – Add "bling" as desired!



Valentine Candy Bouquet Mon, February 8 @ 1:30pm

Supply List

- 2 bags cinnamon candy discs (wrapped)
- 1 box straight pins
- 1 Valentine themed container (gift box, mini-bucket, etc...)
- 2 Styrofoam balls (2")
- 1 wooden dowel or a single chop stick
- Twine, yarn, or jute to wrap dowel
- 1-2 pieces tissue paper
- Craft glue

Instructions

5. Use straight pins to attach wrapped candy to Styrofoam ball
6. Wrap dowel with twine and insert into finished "flower"
7. Place Styrofoam ball into base of container, insert dowel
8. Fill in any open areas of container with tissue paper



Twine Wrapped Valentine Vase Mon, February 15 @ 1:30pm

Supply List

- 1-4 clean, used glass bottles or mason jars
- Acrylic paint (any color), paint brush
- 1-2 rolls of jute, twine, yarn or thin rope
- 1-4 stems of artificial (silk) flowers
- Elmer's "Glue All" or craft glue
- Valentine themed "bling"

Instructions

1. Paint any parts of jar or bottles that will NOT be wrapped with twine
2. Allow painted bottles to dry
3. Using craft glue, wrap twine around entire surface of bottles or jars
4. Add Valentine themed "bling" to bottles
5. Allow containers to dry – Insert flower stems into bottles

Barbeque Kielbassi

- | | |
|---|----------------------------|
| 1. 1 ring (approx. 1 lb.) kielbassi
cut diagonally into pieces | 3. ¼ C. brown sugar |
| 2. 1 C. Bottled Barbeque sauce-your favorite | 4. 1 T. dried minced onion |
| | 5. Ketchup, mustard |

In a saucepan put the barbeque sauce, brown sugar, onion, squirt of ketchup. Add the kielbassi pieces. Cook on stove top for 15-20 minutes over low heat. Serve on rolls, sliders or as an appetizer.

Pittsburgh Potatoes

- | | |
|---|---------------------------------|
| 1. 4 medium potatoes, boiled and skins removed
and then shredded | 4. ½ C. sour cream |
| 2. ½ C. melted margarine | 5. ½ C. shredded cheddar cheese |
| 3. 2 T. dried minced onion | 6. Salt and pepper |

Set oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl combine the shredded potatoes, melted margarine, sour cream and shredded cheddar salt and pepper as desired. Place in a greased casserole. Generously pepper the top of the casserole (Remember Pittsburgh as the smoky city!) Cover with foil and bake for 20-25 minutes until warmed through and cheese has melted.

Lazy Pierogi Casserole

|---|----------------------------|
| • 1 ½ C. elbow macaroni, cooked | • ½ C. (1 stick) margarine |
| • 3 C. Mashed potatoes (3-4 medium potatoes with
½ C. shredded cheddar stirred in before potatoes
are mashed with your favorite recipe) | • 2 T. minced dry onions |

Spray a 2 qt. casserole. Put 1/3 of the cooked macaroni in the casserole and top with the potato mixture and repeat with more macaroni, potatoes and finally the last of the macaroni.

Melt the margarine and stir in the dry onions. Spoon over the top. Cover with foil and place in a 350 degree oven for 20-25 minutes.

Sweet Restaurant Cole Slaw Salad

- | | |
|---|----------------------------------|
| • ½ bag of coleslaw mix | • ¼ C. white sugar |
| • 1 T. diced onion | • ½ t. white vinegar |
| • ½ C. creamy salad dressing (Miracle Whip) | • 1/8 t. salt |
| • 1 T. vegetable oil | • ¼ tsp. poppy seeds, if desired |

In a large bowl combine the cabbage mix and the onion.

In a smaller bowl, whisk the oil, dressing, sugar, vinegar and salt and poppy seeds if using them. Blend thoroughly. Pour over the coleslaw mixture and toss to coat thoroughly. Chill 2 hours before serving.

Haluski (Cabbage and Noodles)

- | | |
|-------------------------------|---|
| • 2 C. shredded cabbage | • 8 oz. medium egg noodles, cooked |
| • 1 medium onion, chopped | • ½ link of kielbassi cut into pieces, diagonally |
| • 1 stick butter or margarine | • Salt and pepper |

In a large skillet melt either the butter or margarine and add the onion and cook until translucent and add the cabbage and continue to cook until the cabbage and onions are soft. Add the cooked egg noodles and the sliced sausage. Combine thoroughly. Salt and pepper as desired. Place into a casserole, cover with foil and cook for 20 minutes.

Strawberry Pie (Eat 'n Park favorite)

- 1 prepared graham cracker pie crust
- 3 C. fresh strawberries, approximately depending on berry size
- ½ C. sugar
- 1 ½ C. water
- 1 3oz. box of strawberry gelatin
- 3 T. cornstarch

Place the fresh strawberries in the graham cracker pie shell. In a small sauce pan bring the water, sugar and cornstarch to a boil. Stir until thick and clear. Remove from the heat and stir in the gelatin and combine thoroughly. Pour over the berries in the pie shell, coat berries well. Refrigerate at least one hour or longer before serving.
